



# Matakana School Swimming Pool Key Contract 2016/17



**Pool can be used from  
Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December until advised**

This is a contract between the school and Parents/Caregivers when keys are signed for. It means that Parents/Caregivers are agreeing to abide by the rules and conditions laid down below. All Parents/Caregivers become partners in the scheme and as such, have the right and the responsibility, to require others to honour the contract and abide by the rules too.

## **THE RULES AND CONDITIONS ARE:**

1. Pool keys are only available to parents/caregivers who have children at Matakana School, or employees of the school (visitors/friends may accompany them). One key is issued per family and keys are not to be shared or duplicated, however it may be used by immediate family members.
2. Children must always have an adult closely supervising them.
3. Jumping, **diving**, running, chasing, dangerous or annoying play is strictly forbidden.
4. No dogs, pets, **food** or glass allowed in the enclosure.
5. All property is to be treated with respect.
6. The gate is to be kept locked at all times and is opened only to allow people in and out.
7. The pool and pool area must be vacated by 8.00pm every night.
8. The pool cover must be treated with care. No sitting or jumping on or from the pool cover roller. The pool cover must be rolled up fully before each swimming session, and the cover should be placed on the pool when your session finishes, the cover reduces the heat loss. **PLEASE DO NOT TIE IT DOWN.**
9. Key holders have the right to require ALL pool users to follow these rules. People who are unable to abide by the above will have their key confiscated. If this occurs, there will be no refund of pool fees. A list of the main key holders' names will be on display in the pool area.
10. Parents/Caregivers are urged to make sure children use the toilets next to the Room 6 before and during swimming time.
11. **The cost of a key is \$100.00 for the season, \$20.00 will be refunded to you, via Kindo if the key is returned by the end of Term 1. This deposit will not be refunded if keys received after that date.**
12. First aid and faecal/vomit accident kits, along with instructions for use, are located in the locked room next to the boys' changing room. Key is the same as the pool gate. In the event of a faecal/vomit accident, you must evacuate the pool immediately and then follow the instructions provided.
